ADMISSION- PROCEDURE

The school admits pupils from all boards subject to availability of seats and eligibility of the applicant. Admission is open to all children from Pre-Montessori class to Grade VIII irrespective of caste, creed, region or gender.

The academic year starts in the month of April. At the beginning of each academic year, prospectus and application forms are issued at the school office.. The prospectus and the registration forms should be collected in person on payment of the registration fee of Rs. 100/-. The duly-filled in forms should be handed over, along with necessary documents, to the school office. Mere registration of the form does not guarantee a seat in the school.

The following table shows the age criteria for admission in our school, the age being reckoned as on 31st of March of the year of admission.

- * At the time of admission, parents are required to produce their child's birth certificate, community certificate, proof of residence, three passport size photos of the child, one joint photo of the child with the parents, and Aadhaar card.
- ★ The transfer certificate and the report card from the school last attended will be required for the kids seeking admission to Grades II and above.
- * Admission will be confirmed on payment of the prescribed fees, he details of which can be had from the school office.

CURRICULUM: World of Wonders

Our child-centered methods include age-appropriate and appealing activities and games. Individualized lessons and self-learning materials, wherever required are provided. Lessons on courtesy, manners and habits are also given much importance.

For Grade 1 to 12 we follow NCERT books and Syllabus by using SSV Teaching Methodology.

The major areas covered in our pre-school curriculum are as follows:

- * Life-skills: Good Work Habits, Concentration, Eye-Hand Coordination, Lengthened Attention Span and Control of Body. The activities include pouring, sorting, care of self like hand washing and dressing oneself, care of the environment like using dustbins and sweeping, and grace and courtesy lessons like saying excuse me and introducing oneself.
- * Learning through the Senses (Sensorial): Exploration of the Environment and Refinement of the Five Senses. The activities include sorting objects, matching colours, matching same tastes or same smells
- *Languages: Improvement of Communication Skills in Tamil and English. The activities include storytelling, interpreting signs and sounds, rhymes and songs, decoding phonetic words, high frequency words, sight words, diphthongs and digraphs.

LIBRARY

We strongly believe that an educational institution is complete only when it has a good, well-stocked library. Stocked with thousands of books and numerous magazines, journals and newspapers to satisfy the voracious bookworms.

SAFETY

The entire campus is covered by CCTV surveillance, around the clock Security Personal, Floor Escorts, Fire Safety installations.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION:

Physical Education is compulsory to all students Facilities for sports like Cricket, Foot ball, Volley ball and Kabadi are available in the school to students from V STD, onwards. A special children's playing park is established in the school. The indoor games facilities are also offered to students of various levels. And also we have a kid's indoor fun play room.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

In order to provide holistic education, school provides different types of co-curricular activities in Literary Club, Science and Eco Club, Mathematics Club, Social and Heritage Club Health and Physical Education Club, IT Club are functioning in the School. Karate classes, Yoga classes, Music classes and Dance classes are conducted and masters in respective fields are appointed to train the students.

HEALTH AND HYGIENE:

The health history of each and every student is maintained in the school. The general state of health of the students is periodically checked up by a qualified medical officer

EXCURSION TRIPS:

Educational tours are organized by the school to provide first hand information and expand the horizons of the pupil's knowledge. Regular educational trips are arranged for the students to enhance their knowledge.

TRANSPORT:

Transport facilities are provided for the students to various localities. This is being achieved with the help of buses and vans. All the buses Fixed with CCTV surveillance. Once a student adopts the transport facility, he/she will not be allowed to cancel it in the middle of the academic year

Late Admission and withdrawal procedures

- * When a child is admitted in the middle of the Year, Registration (Admission) fee and the fees for all the terms, have to be paid.
- * If a student is withdrawn from the school in the middle of the year, all fees due to the school till the end of the term have to be paid.
- * If a student is to be withdrawn from the school at the end of the academic year, notification for such withdrawal must be made in writing to the principal, before 15th of March. If applied after this date, Term I fees for the next year have to be paid.
- * Transfer Certificates will be issued, after the receipt of application for withdrawal, on payment of Rs. 500/- (Five hundred rupees only). Transfer Certificates will not be issued in the month of May.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE STUDENTS

- All the pupils should attend the classes *punctually* with their lessons well prepared. Students should bring books and note books according to the time table.
- All pupils should come to school neat and tidy in the uniform prescribed with school badge. Pupils without proper school uniform shall not be admitted into the classes.
- 3. No student can leave the school premises during the school hours without permission of the Principal.
- 4. This **Diary** must be brought to the school by the pupil every day. Important announcements and home assignments should be recorded in the diary.
- 5. When a pupil sees a member of the staff either within or outside the school, he/she should greet the staff members.
- 6. All students should **converse only in English** in the school premises to acquire greater fluency in the language.
- 7. All applications for leave are to be signed by the parents.
- 8. Every student must take part in the school games unless physically unfit and specially exempted by the Principal.
- Irregular attendance, constant negligence of work insubordination to the teachers, habitual inattentiveness in the class, willful and repeated breach of the school properties will lead pupils to severe penalty or expulsion.
- 10. The student is expected to keep his/her class room and surrounding areas clean and presentable.
- 11. The school property should be handled with care.
- 12. Decorum of School uniform to be maintained at all times with in the campus or outside.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF TEACHERS

- 1. The Teacher must attend the morning assembly daily on time.
- 2. Teacher must address the students on moral principles, social and environment issues during assembly.
- 3. Teacher must follow the conduct rules of school.
- 4. Teacher must maintain the Teacher's Diary regularly with the lesson plan.
- 5. Teacher must reach the class on time for teaching.
- 6. The teacher must evaluate the students from time to time.
- 7. Teachers must make best use of the TLM to develop relevant teaching learning material.
- Class Teachers and Subject Teacher must have regular meetings with parents to keep them informed and guide them about the progress of their ward/wards.
- Subject teachers must discuss among themselves, prepare a schedule and distribute the hamework as per the schedule to avoid over burdening of the students.
- 10. Teachers should *converse only in English* in the school premises to acquire greater fluency in the language.
- Identify the gifted, slow learners, problem children, under-achievers etc. In order to help them achieve according to their needs and abilities.
- 12.To help check truancy and long absenteeism among students to collect and compile information related to career and education from sources like newspapers, magazines etc. and display it through charts, posters, and bulletin boards.
- To organize Career Exhibitions, Field Trip and Counseling Camps in the school.

Note: Apart from above conditions, the teachers have to follow the rules and regulations related to the CBSE norms and the Management conditions.

REQUEST TO PARENTS

- 1. The Parent's full cooperation is very important. We cannot over emphasize the importance of a healthy school/ parent relationship in the upbringing of your child.
- 2. Children should be sent to school in smart dress and in time.
- 3. Children should avoid wearing jewels while coming to school. Management is not responsible for any loss.
- 4. Parents are expected to pay their fees on time to enable smooth functioning of the school.
- 5. Parents must attend 'OPEN DAY' and Parent Teacher Meeting when scheduled.
- 6. Parents must communicate with their child's teachers and enquire about the child's progress not only in academics, sports and co-curricular activities but also in character building development, discipline and social issues.
- 7. Parents are requested not to visit the classes or meet the teachers during class hours but can be collected any required information from school office.
- 8. Serious notice will be taken for absence without leave letter from the examination and at the time of opening and closing days of term.
- 9. For the safety and security of the child kindly intimate any change in the mode of transport
- 10. Parents should check the school diary daily and initial any note sent by the school or teacher.
- 11. Parents are requested to notify the change in their Address if any in the school office.
- 12. No pupil shall be eligible for promotion unless He / She put in attendance of 85% of the total Number of Working days in the whole year. This rule holds good in respect of physical education classes also. Parents are particularly requested to take note of this rule.
- 13. Parents are requested to ensure that the nails of the children are properly trimmed.
